Change of codrivers

Changing the codriver is permitted also during a section and at a time control or stage start. Regulations according to this bulletin apply. Officials of the organisers will check the safety measurements and are authorised to forbid starting a stage.

Procedure when taking guests as codrivers

The guest codriver must fill out and sign the AMF RaceCard form, which is available for Download at <http://www.austria-motorsport.at/media/1068/racecard-antrag-2017.pdf> at the administrative scrutineering personally. The guest codriver receives a permission wristband, which he/she has to wear visibly at all times during the event.

Taking under-aged guests as codrivers

The minimum age for a guest codrive is 16 years. Full and working safety measurements in the car (seats, seatbelts, roll-cage, etc.) and personal safety measures (helmet, shoes, clothes, etc.) must be used. A written letter of agreement and a liability exclusion must be signed by the parents or the legal guardian must be shown.

Retirement procedure and restart

Technical problems, health problems or any other problems may occur. In case you cannot pass a special stage or a time control (no matter why) the organisers must be informed via phone (0043 660 656 0003) or personally. It is possible to skip one or more special stages and restart later, but only if the organisers have been informed about it and gave permission to restart! Unexcused missing of a time control or a special stage will result in immediate exclusion!

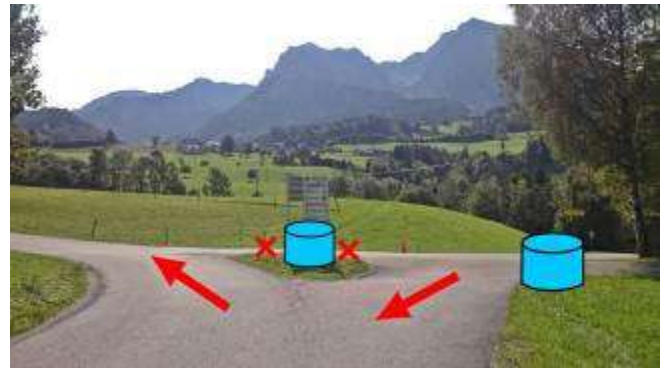
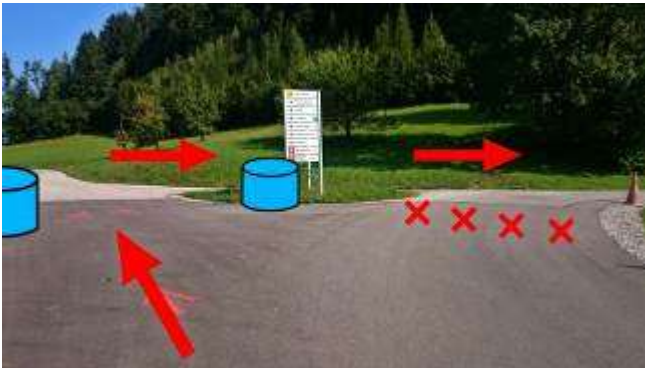
Accidents on special stages

In case you see another competitor car alongside a special stage without OK-sign or warning triangle (no matter if it crashed or not), you have to stop immediately to help the crew and inform the organisers (next radio point or 0043 660 656 0003). Other competitors are often the first people at the scene of an accident and are therefore the fastest way to organise help.
